Guidelines/Instructions to be followed strictly

1. **The Participants who are born on or after 01/01/2013 will take part in the tournament session 2026-2027.**
2. **Form no 05 or 09 No & Adhar copy will be compulsory attached with eligibility form must be attached by the head of the concerned institution along photograph & photograph should be shown the participant name and date of photo.**
3. Identification proof of the participants which includes Name, Father's name, Date of Birth and Photograph attested by the head of the institution is mandatory for participating in Block Level Tournament to National level tournament.
4. Private schools will deposit **40% (Rs. 20/-)** of the sports fund and **60% (Rs.30/-)** of the Donation Fund collected from students of classes 6th to 8th Per student through a bank draft / Cash once a year to DESSA Kangra in the name of Deputy Director of School Education (Elementary) Kangra at Dharamshala.
5. Affiliation Fee:- GSSS/GHS/GMS and Private Schools Rs. 200/-, to be deposited separately once in a year in the office of the Regional Site Holder/Deputy Director of School Education (Elementary) Kangra, Dharamshala.
6. Heads of the institutions are directed to ensure deputation of female teacher to accompany the girls participants from Block level tournament to State level tournament.
7. Heads of institutions are directed to ensure participation of selected players in district and state level competitions.
8. Common mess is mandatory for all participants.
9. **The private schools participating in the tournament are required to bring attested copies of the eligibility form countersigned by the principal of the nearby Government school and copy of their 5/9 number form and certificate will be mandatory.**
10. All DPE/PET who will be on duty will be present in proper uniform (white shirt/T-shirt and black pant during the work and opening/closing ceremony.
11. **The host schools are entitled to claim mess money at the rate of Rs.250/- per day from the boys and girls of private schools Rs.250/- (Per day per player). All the private schools are also directed to participate in the said tournament at the venue near the respective blocks at the same time.**
12. **All DESSA Executive Committee members will visit the Block District Tournament (Boys Girls) venue of their respective Block District and participate in it.**
13. The venue Incharge shall ensure that teacher deputed is adequately attending to the care of the students during the tournament.
14. The trophies purchased in this financial year will be used for the next three years and no budget will be provided for purchase of trophies for the next three years.

15. The Principal/Incharge of the school where the tournament is being organized will be appointed as the supervisor of the tournament. No other officer/employee from any other school will be deputed to the city venue.

16. The following term and conditions to participate in the Yog asana competition.

17. Entry of Teams: You are requested to send the information regarding the participation of your team one week prior to the start of the tournament to the organizing secretary.

18. Girls Team: Mandatorily, the Girls team from each district should be accompanied by at least one lady teacher (**Lect. Phy. Edu. /DPE/PET**) as in-charge who will take care of the girls and will have to stay with the girls during the tournament, and she will be fully qualified for the same. Will be responsible for the girl's troop during their stay.

19. All Escort Teachers/In-Charge will be on the school premises or venue for the safety of the sports persons in their district. Any laxity in the matter will be viewed seriously, and action will be taken against the indiscipline teachers.

20. All Team In-Charge, Lect. Phy. Edu., DPE, PET, and OSD will attend the opening and closing ceremonies. The OSD during the matches will be in proper sports uniform while.

conducting the proramme. Minor games will be played in a league-cum-knockout system.

21. **Reporting Date:** The tour district contingent is expected to reach the venue a day before the start of the competition.

22. **Identity Card:** All players must have an identity card duly signed or attested by the Head of the Institution. Without an identity card, players will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.

23. **AADHAAR CARD:** As per guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, India, and SGFI, online linkage of AADHAAR for each participant of the National School Games at the time of online entries is now mandatory. From session 2023-24 onwards, please ensure to accept the eligibility form as mentioned along with DOB and AADHAAR documents. The DOBs of the participants on the AADHAAR and school certificates should be the same.

24. **Birth Certificate:** A separate photocopy of the birth certificate of each and every player of the team, duly attested by the Gazetted Officer, is required. Only the birth certificate issued by the Statistic Department of the State, UT, Central Govt., Municipal, or Corporation Form-5 Panchayat shall be acceptable for the National School Games as per S. G. F. I. direction. Sports merit and participation certificates will be verified at the venue of state-level tournaments. All the ADPEOS are directed to get the certificates verified at the venue itself.

25. **New Eligibility/ Age Certificate/Bonafide** Certificate signed by Concern H.M/Principal: All players should have official entry and eligibility forms in format (SGFI 20 Col as attached here with.) in full size, duly signed or attested by the head of the institution, and countersigned by the competent authority of the district. The ADPEO and team manager will be responsible for bringing the eligibility and birth certificates of the participants, which are to be handed over to the organizing secretary. In the absence of the above formalities and documents, teams or players will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.

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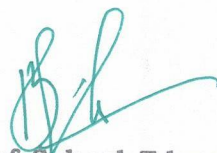
26. **NOC/Risk Certificate:** It has been decided in the General Council meeting of HSSA that henceforth the Head of the Institute shall mandatorily obtain an NOC from the parents or guardians of the players regarding the risk involved while participating in the tournament.

27. **Accommodation:** Arrangements for the stay and mess of all the teams shall be made at the school or hostel premises by the organizing Secretary/ concern Head of school.

28. **Arrangements:** Players and officials will have to bring with them suitable bedding and other personal daily-use items.

29. **Arrangement of mess:** There will be a common mess. It is hereby directed that the supply of food for players during competitions shall be ensured strictly through a competitive bidding (comparative bids) system. The Directorate has emphasized that no compromise in quality shall be tolerated under any circumstances. Preference shall be given to local/Himachali catering service providers while awarding contracts related to food supply for the competitions. It must be ensured that the selected catering agency has previously rendered services successfully in any state-level / District/Block event, and strictly adheres to all norms and standards prescribed by the Food Safety and Standards.

30. **Non compliance of order shall lead to appropriate disciplinary action against the defaulting officials.**

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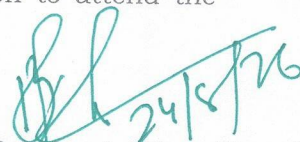

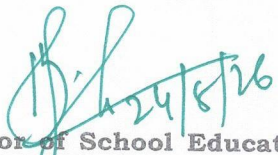
Subject :- Regarding organizing district level sports competitions for Under-14 students.

Sir/Madam,

In reference to the above subject, it is directed that Under-14 Boys and Girls sports competitions are proposed/scheduled to be held in the respective Blocks. In this regard, all DESSA Block Committees are directed to visit the venues of the competitions to be held in their respective Blocks and ensure inspection and experience of all arrangements.

The availability of special drainage systems should be ensured during inspection:

1. Provision of proper playground and sports equipment for the players.
2. Proper arrangements for food, clean drinking water and toilets for the players.
3. First aid/medical facilities are available as needed.
4. There should be proper arrangements for accommodation and rest for the students.
5. Necessary separate and safe facilities should be ensured for girls students.
6. All the necessary facilities should be made available to every player participating in the competition.
7. The competitions should be conducted in a fair and systematic manner as per the prescribed DSSA rules and guidelines. Therefore, all the Block Committees are directed to personally inspect the competition venue in their respective zones and check the above arrangements and if any deficiency is found, then before the start of the competition, the concerned Organizing Committee should ensure to send the report of the venue in-charge/ School inspection and a detailed report of the action taken to the Deputy Director's office within two days.
